Short-Deck Poker: How to Play 6+ Hold'em (Official Rules)

What is Short Deck

Poker?

Short-deck poker (also known as six-plus hold'em) is a new variation of traditional Texas hold'em that mostly follows the same rules albeit with a significant difference.

Short-deck poker uses a smaller 36-card deck rather than the full 52-card deck.

Most first heard of short-deck poker after it was introduced among the mix in the high-stakes cash games in Macau.

Short-Deck Poker Rules

Before we discover how to

play short-deck poker, let's see how to get to the 36-card deck needed to play a game of 6+ hold'em.

The 36-card deck in use in poker short deck is created by removing the 2xs, 3xs, 4xs, and 5xs from the deck (16 cards).

That leaves the 6xs up through the Kxs as well as the Axs.

What about the Aces?

As in regular hold'em, in short-deck poker the aces still count as high or low when making straights.

The lowest possible straight in

a game of short-deck poker is Ax9x8x7x6x (think of the ace as essentially replacing the missing 5x).

Poker short-deck is played similarly to regular hold'em.

Each player

receive two hole cards and use them in combination with five community cards to create the best possible hand.

A game of short-deck poker features four streets of betting:

Pre-flop Flop Turn River

However, there are some differences in the short-deck poker that you should know about before playing.

Short-Deck Poker Hand

Rankings

Short-deck poker can be played according to the exact same rules as regular Texas Hold'em.

The betting can be fixed-limit or no-limit (although most often the game is played no-limit), and the same hand rankings can be used as follows:

Hand Ranking

Hand Name Poker Hand Lowest High card Kx6x9x8xQx One pair KK5x8xQx Two pair KK66Qx
Three-of-a-kind KKK6Qx Straight A6789 Flush KJ1069x Full house KKK66
Four-of-a-kind KKKK6x Straight flush A6789 Highest Royal flush 10JQKA

Alternative Short-Deck Hand Rankings

Short-deck poker is

played often employing a different hand ranking system. Here are the alternate hand rankings for short-deck poker (note the differences in bold):

Hand Ranking Hand Name

Poker Hand Lowest High card Kx6x9x8xQx One pair KK5x8xQx Two pair KK66Qx Straight
A6789 Three of a kind KKK6Qx Full house KKK66 Flush KJ1069x Four of a
kind KKKK6x Straight flush A6789 Highest Royal flush 10JQKA

As you can

see, following these alternate poker short deck hand rankings a three-of-a-kind beats a straight (instead of vice-versa), and a flush beats a full house (instead of vice-versa).

Why a Different Hand Rankings?

These changes were introduced because

the removal of cards from the standard deck alter the probabilities of making certain hands.

For example, with only nine suited cards (instead of 13), a flush is harder to make in short-deck poker than in regular hold'em.

Six-Plus Hold'em Variation — The Deal (Fifth Street)

One other popular variation often introduced in six-plus hold'em has to do with the way the river is dealt.

The game can be played according to the same procedure followed in regular hold'em, with the community cards coming in the same way — flop (three cards), turn (one card), and river (one card) — and betting rounds after each street.

More often, though, instead of a river card being dealt to complete a five-card board, players are each dealt a third hole card instead.

Players then make

their five-card poker hands by using exactly two of their three hole cards and three of the four community cards.

The building of hands resembles the procedure followed in

Omaha poker where players must use two of their four hole cards plus three board cards to make a five-card poker hand.

Short-Deck Poker Basic Strategy

As you might imagine, the removal of low cards and use of the 36-card deck makes it more likely to make higher value hands, a change that tends to introduce more action.

You should adjust your thinking about relative hand values from what they are used to in regular hold'em.

The smaller deck makes it easier to make two-pair hands, which means a hand like top pair-top kicker is no longer as strong in six-plus hold'em as it is in regular hold'em.

Straights and full houses are also easier to make in six-plus hold'em than in the regular version of the game (a reason for the alternate hand rankings).

The odds of hitting certain draws change, too, in short-deck poker.

Just to highlight one example, filling an open-ended straight draw becomes more likely in short-deck poker.

While you're still looking for the same eight outs there are fewer total cards in the deck, thus increasing the percentage you'll make your straight.

The smaller deck also affects the likelihood of being dealt certain hands. []You're more than twice as likely to get pocket aces in short-deck poker than you are in regular hold'em!

Finally, players being dealt a third hole card instead of there being a fifth community card obviously affects hand values as well, making it even more likely that players improve their hands — yet another factor that has to be taken into account when calculating odds and considering your final-round betting strategy.

Conclusion

Short-deck poker / 6+ hold'em introduces several exciting twists to traditional Texas hold'em, creating an action-filled alternative that many players are finding especially enjoyable to play.

The changes from regular hold'em aren't terribly complicated, making it easy to new players to learn and play right away.

Triunfalismo de la Premier League es poco probable que se disipe pronto, incluso durante un 2024 castigador

Los desempeños en las competiciones de clubes de la UEFA el año pasado fueron decepcionantes. Aunque Rodri fue nombrado jugador del torneo, la Euro 2024 luchó por el polvo de estrellas de la Premier League. En su final, un equipo español con una columna vertebral de Real Sociedad y Athletic Bilbao se merecidamente venció a un equipo de estrellas de la liga inglesa de alto nivel.

Como proveedor de contenido, la Premier League aún puede jactarse sin demasiada censura. La libra esterlina 5 mil millones recibida por derechos nacionales y las libra esterlina 5.05 mil millones desde 2024 hasta 2025 por derechos internacionales superan con creces a sus competidores, aunque en comparación con las libra esterlina 7.7 mil millones por temporada que recibe la NFL, el cuerpo dirigido por Richard Masters aún debe inclinarse.

Los dos productos estadounidenses, la NBA y la NFL, han innovado los acuerdos que Masters et al han seguido, cortando y picando el contenido para las partes que no están dispuestas a pagar una gran rebanada. El acuerdo de la NFL del día de Navidad por dos partidos, valorado en R\$150 millones (£116 millones), abrió una nueva puerta para Netflix, el transmisor mundial dominante, para mostrar deportes en vivo. Seguramente seguirán más.

Aun así, dentro del fútbol, la Premier League sigue siendo una competencia de su propia clase. Los €200 millones (£168 millones) que la Bundesliga recibe anualmente de los derechos internacionales apenas superan una décima parte de los €1.9 mil millones de su equivalente inglés.

En segundo lugar está La Liga, muy por encima de sus años Messi-Ronaldo. Vendió los

derechos de los acuerdos en el extranjero en 2024 por €897 millones al año. Un acuerdo a largo plazo en los EE. UU. con ESPN hasta 2029, informado que vale R\$1.5 mil millones, se extiende sobre ese tiempo. Si el último acuerdo doméstico de La Liga, que se ejecuta hasta 2026-27, fue por €5 mil millones, fue durante cinco años, y no los tres para Inglaterra. Del mismo modo, el último acuerdo doméstico de la Serie A fue por €4.88 mil millones en cinco años. Mientras tanto, en los EE. UU., los derechos de la Serie A, vendidos a CBS, se informaron al New York Times como significativamente menos que el acuerdo anterior firmado en 2024, alrededor de R\$60-70 millones anualmente.

¿Existe alguna amenaza para la dominancia de la Premier League? Por ningún medio inmediatamente, aunque la turbulencia en los mercados europeos competidores puede señalar problemas futuros, al igual que la marea de interés propio y mala gestión financiera de los clubes élite. El caos en Ligue 1, que amenaza a los clubes de la primera división francesa con la posible bancarrota en algunos casos, debería servir como una advertencia. La estabilidad de la asociación senior de la Premier League con BSkyB, que data de 1992, apoyada en la última década por BT Sports y luego por el sucesor TNT, no debe darse por sentado.

Los ejecutivos de Ligue 1, desprovistos de Lionel Messi, Neymar y ahora Kylian Mbappé, querían más de €1 mil millones por sus derechos de televisión, pero no encontraron postores. Habiendo rechazado previamente a los socios a largo plazo Canal+, cuya asociación con Ligue 1 se remonta a 1984, y Qatar's BeIn Sport, un socio desde 2011, los ejecutivos optaron por un acuerdo de 2024 con Mediapro que fue retirado por la empresa española después de solo seis meses y condujo a un rescate apresurado. El plato de mendicidad estaba de nuevo hasta este mes, con Canal+ y BeIn no dispuestos a donar.

La semana pasada, un acuerdo combinado de alrededor de €500 millones se hizo con Dazn - el ambicioso transmisor con sede en Londres con carteras nacionales en España, Alemania e Italia, cuya fórmula para el éxito, según los expertos en medios deportivos, es seguir gastando hasta que el dinero vuelva a entrar - y Amazon, quien mostrará un juego a la semana por €100 millones por temporada. Eso fue el 50% de los ingresos por televisión proyectados. Con las finanzas ya dañadas por el error de Mediapro y Covid-19, no es de extrañar que el talento como Leny Yoro de Lille, recientemente firmado por Manchester United, se canjee fácilmente.

Mientras tanto, la atracción de Ligue 1 para los transmisores extranjeros se reduce exponencialmente. Un producto estresado siempre será menos comercializable, y para otras compañías, los números no siempre suman. El retiro de BT de la provisión de contenido, la fusión con Discovery para formar TNT, fue la conclusión de una misión para frenar las incursiones de Sky en el negocio de banda ancha y teléfono. Sky, propiedad de Comcast desde 2024 después de que Rupert Murdoch cobrara, puede tener que responder algún día a los vientos en el mundo empresarial estadounidense, ya que la tecnología emergente y los eventos mundiales más allá del deporte tienen su efecto.

¿Qué mata al pavo real de oro? La avaricia encabeza la lista. Los antiguos titulares de la corona de la liga más grande del mundo, la Serie A de la década de 1980 hasta principios de la década de 2000 y La Liga en la era Real Madrid-Barcelona de finales de la década de 2000 hasta mediados de la década de 2010, ambas cayeron en la desgracia económica. ¿Es la Premier League demasiado fuerte para escapar ese destino? Un número de clubes tienen casos financieros y legales pendientes, con Everton, Chelsea y Manchester City a la vanguardia. Solo los ingenuos declararían que no podría suceder aquí.
