15:1 CHILD-TO-COACH RATIO Often a child's first experience with group learning, this class is designed to give them a perfect start.

Managing a class full of toddlers can be like herding kittens.

They're playful, sometimes skittish and easily distracted.

But with the right structure and interactions, a lot can happen.

Activities with bubbles, parachutes, cones and other sensory toys build skills for balance, coordination, running, tracking, kicking and changing directions-all building blocks needed for playing soccer.

With parents by their side, our youngest Lil' Kickers feel safe to explore new experiences and create new relationships while learning in a fun and dynamic environment.

2 – 3 YEARSADULT INTERACTIVE

14:1 CHILD-TO-COACH RATIO* *Ratios are subject to change pending Governor's guidelines.

In this class, kids begin to learn to actively engage with the coach and other players.

"Why?" Hang around enough with this age group of curious, older toddlers and you will hear that word a lot.

Working with Thumpers and their parents, we welcome their inquisitive nature and sense of wonderment in learning.

We use those traits to shape confidence and self-esteem to further build core movements like balance, coordination and timing—all necessary for mastering a soccer ball.

While parent involvement continues here, this class bridges the gap between parallel play and directly interacting with the coach and other players.

So "why" take a Thumpers class? Because it is a blast.

2½ – 3½ YEARSADULT INTERACTIVE

7:1 or 14:2 CHILD-TO-COACH RATIO Here, preschoolers who are not quite ready to be on the field alone discover some independence.

Terrible twos? Not in our opinion! Though toddler behavior can be puzzling, these little ones are

just trying to put the pieces together to grow into the person they are meant to be. Sometimes they get frustrated and their feelings come out sideways, especially when they are shy and a little tentative.

We embrace the complexities of this time of life and help them transition into being more interactive, confident, self-reliant and relational.

We do so with fun and engaging games that help them begin to master basic movement and ball control skills.

The goal is to get them to be more interactive with the coach, to play with (rather than alongside) their peers and to engage in the game.

Max Verstappen logra la pole en el Gran Premio de Emilia-Romagna, igualando el récord de Ayrton Senna

Max Verstappen tuvo que realizar una remontada que consideró la mejor de los últimos cinco años para conseguir la pole position en el Gran Premio de Emilia-Romagna. Una vuelta sobresaliente bajo una gran presión lo colocó junto a Ayrton Senna con un récord de octava pole consecutiva.

En el año del 30º aniversario de la muerte de Senna en Imola, Verstappen tuvo que esforzarse, después de dos días difíciles en los que él y Red Bull han tenido problemas con el agarre y el equilibrio del coche. Estaba fuera de forma y retrasado en cuanto a ritmo, pero lo aprovechó cuando importaba frente a una gran carga de los McLaren de Oscar Piastri en segundo y Lando Norris en tercero.

Verstappen y McLaren, a la caza de la victoria

Verstappen ha conseguido ocho poles consecutivas, comenzando con Abu Dabi el año pasado, lo que iguala el récord de Senna entre el Gran Premio de España de 1988 y el Gran Premio de los Estados Unidos de 1989. Igualar a Senna en el fin de semana en el que se honra al tres veces campeón significó mucho para el holandés.

El domingo será una dura batalla entre Verstappen y McLaren, ya que Norris está dispuesto a luchar por la victoria. La escudería británica ha demostrado su potencial y puede ser el equipo mejor situado para desafiar a Red Bull.
