Astase Feminino fechouabet generalized as the third free practice session for the Japanese Grand Prix. Here are the main highlights and opinion of the F1Mania team on the performance of the teams and drivers on Friday.

Mercedes dominance continues: Mercedes continued its dominance on Friday, with Lewis Hamilton and Valtteri Bottas finishing in the top two positions in both free practice sessions. The Silver Arrows seem to have found a significant pace advantage over their competitors, especially in the long runs.

Ferrari struggles: Ferrari had a difficult day, with Sebastian Vettel and Charles Leclerc failing to impress in either practice session. Vettel struggled with a lack of grip, while Leclerc faced issues with his car's balance. The Scuderia will need to improve significantly if they hope to challenge Mercedes on Sunday.

Verstappen on the pace: Max Verstappen was the closest challenger to Mercedes in both practice sessions, finishing third in FP1 and FP2. The Red Bull driver appears to have found a rhythm around the Suzuka Circuit, and could be a threat to the Silver Arrows on Sunday.

McLaren shows promise: McLaren had a positive day, with Carlos Sainz Jr. and Lando Norris finishing in the top ten in both practice sessions. The team's pace suggests that they could be a force to be reckoned with in the upcoming races.

Ricciardo frustrated: Renault's Daniel Ricciardo endured a disappointing day, finishing outside the top ten in both practice sessions. The Australian driver expressed frustration with his car's performance, citing a lack of grip and balance issues.

RB16 scrutineered: Red Bull's Alex Albon was forced to abandon his car in FP2 after smoke started billowing from the rear of his RB16. The team has confirmed that the issue was caused by a suspected oil leak, and Albon was unable to set a lap time.

Giovinazzi impresses: Alfa Romeo's Antonio Giovinazzi enjoyed a solid day, finishing in the top ten in FP1 and narrowly missing out on Q3 in FP2. The young Italian driver continues to impress, and his performance suggests that he could be a contender for a race seat next season.

Raikkonen involved in controversy: Alfa Romeo's Kimi Räikkönen was involved in a controversial incident in FP1, when he appeared to impede Mercedes' Valtteri Bottas during a hot lap. The Finnish driver received criticism from several drivers and teams, including Mercedes' Toto Wolff, who described Raikkonen's actions as "dangerous."

Gasly struggles continue: Pierre Gasly endured another difficult day, finishing outside the top ten in both practice sessions. The French driver continues to struggle with his Red Bull car, and his future with the team remains uncertain.

Sainz Jr. sets the pace: McLaren's Carlos Sainz Jr. set the fastest lap time in FP2, clocking a 1:28.537, narrowly ahead of Mercedes' Lewis Hamilton. The Spaniard appears to be in excellent form, and could challenge for a podium finish on Sunday.

P Hamilton fastest in FP1: Lewis Hamilton was the fastest driver in FP1, setting a 1:29.726. The Briton's pace was impressive, considering he used a harder compound tire than his rivals.

Ricciardo philosophical: Daniel Ricciardo remains philosophical about his struggles this season, commenting that he is focusing on his own performance rather than dwelling on the team's issues. The Australian driver expressed confidence that he and the team can turn their season around.

Russell impresses: Williams' George Russell continues to impress, despite his team's struggles.

The young Briton finished in the top ten in both practice sessions, and is one to watch for the future.

Grid penalties likely: Both Ferrari drivers face grid penalties for Sunday's race, after taking new engine components exceeding their seasonal limits. The penalties are expected to be announced shortly.

Stroll: Stroll struggles continued, with the Canadian driver failing to impress in either practice session. The RP19 has been plagued by balance issues this season, and the team will need to rectify this if they hope to challenge their competitors.
