American reality television series

Poker Royale is a television series on the Game Show

Network (GSN), which featured No Limit Texas 3 hold 'em Poker. The first series began on December 7, 2004. The eighth and final series, Poker Royale: Young Bloods 3 II, began airing on December 9, 2005. The series host at its conclusion was John Ahlers, with commentary by Robert 3 Williamson III and sideline reporting by Lisa Dergan.

Poker Royale: The WPPA Championship [edit]

The first 3 series was based on the championship of the World Poker Players Association. The show was hosted by Kevin Nealon, with 3 commentary by Williamson (Evelyn Ng provided commentary for the first two episodes). Suzanne Freeman provided sideline reporting. A total of 3 72 players participated and put up theR\$5,000 entrance fee.

Unlike later series, this series was done in a tournament-style format where 3 players who had zero chips were eliminated. Also different from other series were that three tables were active during the 3 early episodes, and was later lowered to the top ten players at the main table in center stage.

This was the 3 only series where there was a contest for viewers. During intervals of the program, various poker buzzwords would appear on 3 screen. Viewers would log into GSN's website and input this word for a chance to win up toR\$10,000,000 in a 3 poker hand with the winner of the WPPA championship.

In order to win the grand prize, the poker tournament winner had 3 to get a full house or better by choosing 5 cards from a deck at random (each card was sealed 3 in an envelope). James Van Alstyne won the tournament and

shared an additional R\$30,000 with a member of GSN's website, in addition to the cash received, they each won a year's supply of pizza from Pizza Hut.

Poker Royale: Battle of the Sexes [edit]

Poker

Royale: 3 Battle of the Sexes was the second series, hosted by radio personality Tom Leykis and Kennedy. Additional commentary was by 3 Williamson once again, except for preliminary match #6, when Matt Vaspersian covered for him. Suzanne Freeman again returned as sideline 3 reporter.

As opposed to the previous series, this one relied on males vs. females, which also incorporated the current scoring format, 3 where players would be awarded points for their teams, depending on how they finished in that particular episode (one point 3 for finishing sixth place to six points for finishing first). The six players (three each of men and women) who 3 had the highest points played in a grand final with the same rules as above, and the highest team score 3 won the tournament and the 6 teammates split a R\$30,000 bonus (\$5,000 each) each daily winner also received R\$20,000, each finalist received 3 a R\$5,000 bonus and the tournament's overall winner won R\$40,000. Kathy Liebert won the tournament and a total of R\$50,000. Despite losing all 3 6 preliminary games the women scored the most points at the final table to capture the R\$30,000 bonus.

The men were Chris 3 Moneymaker, Paul Wolfe, Greg Raymer, Amir Vahedi, Layne Flack and Antonio Esfandiari. The women were Kathy Liebert, Jennifer Harman, Evelyn 3 Ng, Karina Jett, Kristy Gazes and Clonie Gowen.

Poker Royale: Celebrities vs. Poker Pros

featured famous poker players playing against celebrities. As before, the scoring system 3 was used, but was altered (10 points for finishing first down to 0 points for finishing last). The six highest 3 point-scorers would play in the grand final for the championship.

The celebrities who participated in this tournament were Lance Bass, Jennifer 3 Tilly, Mimi Rogers, Morris Chestnut, Patrick Warburton, and Traci Bingham. They faced poker players Scott Fischman, Kathy Liebert, Cyndy Violette, 3 Roxanne Rhodes,

Paul Darden, and "Cowboy" Kenna James. John Ahlers became the permanent host with this series and Lisa Dergen became permanent sideline reporter. Matt Savage and Bill Bruce were the Tournament Directors.

Patrick Warburton was the eventual winner and received \$50,000, 3 Preliminary match winners each received \$5,000, finalists won a \$5,000 bonus.

Poker Royale: Young Bloods [edit]

Poker Royale: Young Bloods was a

3 live special that premiered on May 20, 2005. It initially ran approximately 2 hours 15 minutes. Subsequent airings were edited for a two-hour timeslot. All the players were under the age of 30. Players were awarded cash prizes based on the order of finish. The winner received \$20,000, second place \$10,000, and third-sixth received \$5,000. The players were Michael Mizrachi, David Williams, Michael Sandberg, Erin Ness, Erica Schoenberg, and Scott Fischman. There were two final table events between these players. In the first event, Williams defeated Ness heads-up to take the win. Sandberg took third. In the second event, Williams outlasted Sandberg heads-up. Mizrachi took third.

Poker Royale: Comedians vs. Poker Pros [edit]

Poker Royale: Comedians vs.

Poker Pros was similar to Celebrities vs. Poker Pros, but with stand-up comedians in lieu of celebrities. This series had more preliminary games than in previous series (ten instead of the previous six). The comedians were Paul Rodriguez, Robert Wuhl, Mark Curry, Tammy Pescatelli, Carol Leifer, and Sue Murphy. They faced off against poker players Phil Laak, Robert Williamson III, Linda Johnson, David Williams, Connie Kim, and Kathy Kolberg. Since Williamson was a competitor, "Cowboy" Kenna James took the commentator spot for this series. In this tournament the top 2 comedians and top 2 pros were guaranteed a place in the finale with the next top 3 of each team having to earn a spot through the wild card game played for no money. Phil Laak won the tournament and the \$50,000 grand prize, Kathy Kolberg finished runner-up and received \$10,000.

Poker Royale: The James
Woods Gang vs. the Unabombers featured two 3 teams featuring celebrities and poker pros.
Once again, the point system was used, but this time points were combined into 3 a total
score for the whole team as opposed to scores for individual players. In the grande
finale, each team 3 captain and 2 team members of his choice divided this total
multiplied by R\$10,000 in chips (choosing who would get the 3 extra chips if it could not

be divided evenly), each preliminary winner received R\$5,000, the winning team split R\$50,000, while the overall 3 individual winner won R\$25,000. The James Woods Gang was led by celebrity and poker player James Woods, and had celebrities Nicole Sullivan, and Bob Goen, plus poker players Kathy Liebert, Ted Forrest, and Susie Isaacs. The Unabombers were led by Phil Laak. His team had celebrities Jennifer Tilly, Danny Masterson, and Gail O'Grady, plus poker players Hasan Habib and Cyndy Violette. Matt Savage and Bill Bruce returned as the Tournament Directors.

Poker Royale: Battle of the Ages [edit]

Poker 3 Royale: Battle

of the Ages was the most recent series of Poker Royale. This one featured six poker players over 3 the age of 60 playing against six players under the age of 30. The older players were T. J. Cloutier, 3 "Action" Dan Harrington, "Miami" John Cernuto, Barbara Enright, Maureen Feduniak, and Wendeen Eolis. The younger players were Michael Gracz, Dutch Boyd, Erin Ness, Evelyn Ng, Jennifer Leigh, and Kasey Thompson. A bounty was introduced for each episode. At the beginning 3 of each show each player would be dealt a card, the one with the ace of spades would be the 3 "bounty" if he or she lost whoever eliminated them won a R\$1,000 bonus. (splitting the prize if more than one player 3 was involved) if he/she went on to win they would receive the R\$1,000 bonus. Matt Savage and Bill Bruce were, once 3 again, the Tournament Directors.

Poker 3 Royale: Young Bloods II [edit]

Poker Royale: Young Bloods II was another

special featuring poker players under 30, and 3 aired on December 9, 2005. This special featured the same players and format as the first Young Bloods.

Kenna James once 3 again

did commentary instead of Williamson for this special.

Airings [edit]

GSN aired new

episodes of Poker Royale every Friday 3 evening from 10:00 p.m. to 11:00 p.m. EST, part of their Casino Night block (the block has since moved to 3 Mondays, and does not feature Poker Royale). Episodes of previous seasons are rerun occasionally on GSN.

As of 2006 ,

GSN 3 does not intend to do any more Poker Royale shows. A cash game poker show titled High Stakes Poker premiered 3 on January 16, 2006 on GSN. This series is unrelated to Poker Royale. GSN has since returned its focus exclusively 3 to game shows, and they reverted their on air branding to Game Show Network, so it is unlikely that reruns 3 or a new series of Poker Royale will air on the network in the foreseeable future.

Liga Nacional de Aficionados a los Rompecabezas: La Asociación de EE. UU. Más Antigua de Aficionados a los Rompecabezas del Mundo

La Liga Nacional de Aficionados a los Rompecabezas es la asociación de aficionados a los acertijos del mundo más antigua. Activa en los EE. UU. más o menos continuamente desde 1883, su producción incluye estos maravillosos anagramas, que obedecen a la restricción de que los anagramas deben ser adecuados a las palabras originales:

greyhound / hey, dog run! (1898)

un punto decimal / soy un punto en su lugar (1928)

HMS Pinafore / nombre de barco (1975)

snooze alarms / lástima, no más Zs (1982)

La LNA también es la inventora y difusora de una forma única de rompecabezas, el "plano", al que se dedica el resto de esta columna. El plano es una pequeña pieza de verso ligero con algunas palabras faltantes, lo que lo hace como un acertijo cruzado críptico sofisticado y rimado.

Tal como:

1. HETERONYM (4 6, 4 3 3)

Estación de guardabosques cerca de lago congelado:

Dos señales publicadas UNIÓN y BREAK

=HOT, Berkeley CA

Todos los planos tienen la misma forma. El título explica el tipo de juego de palabras, y el número de letras en la respuesta. Las palabras en MAYÚSCULAS son las palabras faltantes, es decir, los espacios en el texto donde cada respuesta va, en orden. La línea final es el seudónimo del autor y la dirección.

En el ejemplo anterior, "heterónimo" significa que la respuesta son dos frases que consisten en las mismas letras en el mismo orden. Una frase tiene longitudes de palabras 4 y 6. La otra tiene longitudes de palabras 4 y 3 y 3.

Respuesta:

oficina del parque , oficina del parque fuera del hielo

Los planos tienen su origen en una tradición estadounidense (importada del Reino Unido) de adivinanzas en verso que se remonta al siglo XVIII. Son ingeniosos, caprichosos y divertidos. Una vez que los dominas, son un deleite. Aquí hay tres heterónimos más. He incluido pistas, ya que pueden ser tricky para los no iniciados.

2. HETERONYM (6 3 4, *5 *2 *6)

Ve cómo él PRIMAL deftly sobre su telescopio hecho a mano –
Él estudiará FINAL, tranquilo ahora, con hermoso pendiente nevado.

pista: se trata de un volcán inactivo en el noroeste de EE. UU.

3. HETERONYM (3 4, 7, 2 5)

Entonces, retrocediendo a través del DOS
Tenga un refrigerio de espinacas TRES
(Cualquier cosa verde servirá).
=[ANÓNIMO]

pista: Aragorn es un personaje en el Señor de los Anillos (representado en la parte superior). La segunda línea requiere un detalle adicional: en el lugar al que se está retirando puede haber manzanas en los árboles.

4. HETERONYM (6, 2 4)

Él era un principiante, un tyro, un UNO.
DOS o pecado oscuro. Él simplemente no había comenzado.
=NEWROW, Brookline MA

Los planos pueden ser uno de docenas de tipos de juegos de palabras. El REBUS, por ejemplo, es cuando una imagen presenta una lectura heterónima de la respuesta. En otras palabras, la imagen describe una frase que contiene las mismas letras en el mismo orden que la solución.

5. REBUS (14)

Levanto mi copa en el Día de la Madre
"A Mamá – has ganado tu paga de combate.
Tu entusiasmo por criar canijos me falta.
¿Quién necesita lloriqueos, peleas o ataques?"
=CRAX, Mountain View CA

nota para los nerds de las palabras: el segundo estanco es un pangrama, es decir, contiene cada letra del alfabeto. nota para los bebedores: el cóctel navegable es un cóctel.

abuelo (G; R y P no están en G)

6. REBUS (*3 *4 *5)

Una película como RESPUESTA muestra que hay un gran disfrute
En bailar desnudo cuando se enfrenta al desempleo.
=MO' NATURAL, Pebblework CY

7. REBUS (6 6)

Se enorgullece de ser elegante.
La imagen de sí mismo es un negocio complicado, aunque.
Es un poco lento y torpe para ser justos.
Él es TODO, aunque es el último en saberlo.
=NEWROW, Brookline MA

pista: el animal a la izquierda es un roedor común, y el animal a la derecha requiere un artículo.

8. REBUS (*6 2 8)

En RESPUESTA revuelva por una mayor masa
Que Idaho cercano? No lo sé.
=NEWROW, Brookline MA

pista: mire el contenido de la estampilla 1, luego la estampilla 2, luego las estampillas 3 y 4 juntas. La respuesta contiene una ortografía americanizada, es decir, una 'o' donde en el Reino Unido escribiríamos 'ou'.

9. REBUS (6,6)

=HOAX

pista: lo ingenioso aquí es que tanto el juego de palabras como una representación de la respuesta están en la imagen

10. REBUS (15 17)

El teléfono suena.
Contesto y cuelgo.
Odio HAIKU.
= MR. TEX

(MR TEX, por cierto, es Mike Reiss, un exshowrunner de la serie animada Los Simpson.)

A continuación, otro tipo de juego de palabras. En un homónimo, las respuestas se escriben de manera diferente pero suenan igual.

11. HOMONYM (3, 4, 4)

=TOONHEAD!, Boston MA

pista: hay tres palabras aquí, todas escritas de manera diferente, pero todas pronunciadas idénticamente cuando se hablan con un acento estadounidense. (Este es probablemente mi favorito.) Cuando se habla con un acento británico, dos tienen un diptongo y se pronuncian idénticamente y el tercero sin diptongo está muy cerca de los otros dos.

12. HOMONYM (10, 3 9)

Mi tipo se volvió rebelde.
Él congeló mi máquina.
Él quiere que pague.
Él se escapó limpio.
No puedo acceder a los archivos.
Él se llevó lo mío.
Estoy asombrado de que
Desplegó DIEZ, luego TRES NUEVE.

pista: esto es muy oportuno, especialmente si eres usuario de la Biblioteca Británica,

El plano final es una mezcla de homónimo y rebus. La imagen describe un homónimo de la respuesta.

13. REBUS FONÉTICO (9)
